APPENDIX F – ROADLESS AREAS WITH POTENTIALLY HIGHER RISK FOR WILDLIFE

INTRODUCTION

This appendix includes terrestrial (land-based) animal species that are threatened, endangered, or sensitive, which could potentially be affected by the alternatives evaluated in this EIS. Threatened and endangered (T&E) species refer to those that are federally listed under the Endangered Species Act (ESA). Forest Service sensitive species are those listed by a regional forester (in Regions 2 or 4), primarily based on population viability concerns (USDA Forest Service 1995; Forest Service manual 2670). The sensitive species listed in Regions 2 or 4 include species identified as “candidate” species for federal listing under the ESA.

Roadless areas with potentially higher risk for wildlife are those roadless areas with: high biodiversity or presence of special status terrestrial animal species; important boreal toad or other amphibian breeding sites; bat maternity sites; designated critical habitats; lynx denning sites; and important wintering, production, migratory, or landscape linkage corridors. In addition to having one or more of those species or habitat features, the potentially higher risk areas are those where road-building or tree-cutting activities are likely to occur under one or more of the alternatives evaluated in this EIS. The projected roading and tree-cutting activities were described in the Analysis Framework section of chapter 3, and in more detail in Appendix C. Identifying these areas as potentially higher risk for wildlife is not intended to minimize the values of other roadless areas for wildlife. Refer to the Terrestrial Species and Habitat section of chapter 3, and the specialist report in the EIS record, for further detail regarding this analysis.

Table F-1 lists those roadless areas with potentially higher risk for wildlife. In order to account for all such roadless areas, it includes Colorado roadless area names (CRAs) as well as the portions of inventoried roadless areas (IRAs) that lie outside the CRAs. The portions of IRAs that are not included in CRAs are referred to generally in this appendix as “substantially altered” (SA) areas. In addition to listing the national forest and particular CRA or SA acres considered potentially higher risk for wildlife, it also lists the specific terrestrial threatened, endangered and sensitive species associated with that particular roadless area. The last columns show some of the important habitat features known to occur in those particular roadless areas.

This table is associated with the map titled *Roadless Areas with Potentially Higher Risk for Wildlife*, contained in the map packet.
