Eagle Lake Ranger District to Host Educational Snowshoe Walks

Susanville, CA...There is nothing like spending time outside during the winter to breathe in the crisp air and enjoy the winter wonderland on snow shoes. The Eagle Lake Ranger District will begin their winter snowshoe walk and education programs in January. "This is a great opportunity for people to try a new activity and learn more about the forest and wildlife in winter," said Jill Poulsen of the Eagle Lake Ranger District.



Walks will be held each Wednesday in January from 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. and we will meet participants at the Eagle Lake Ranger District Office. On Saturday, January 10 there will be a moonlight walk starting at 7:00 p.m., participants will meet at the intersection of Highway 44 and the Goumaz/Hog Flat Road (Forest Road 30N03). On Saturday, January 24, participants will meet at 10:00 a.m. at the Fredonyer Snowmobile Park on Highway 36 near the top of Fredonyer Pass.

Interested participants are advised to call and reserve their space for the walks and to bring a hat, gloves, water, snacks, snow boots, sunglasses, and dress in layers. The Forest Service will provide snowshoes.
