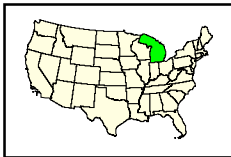
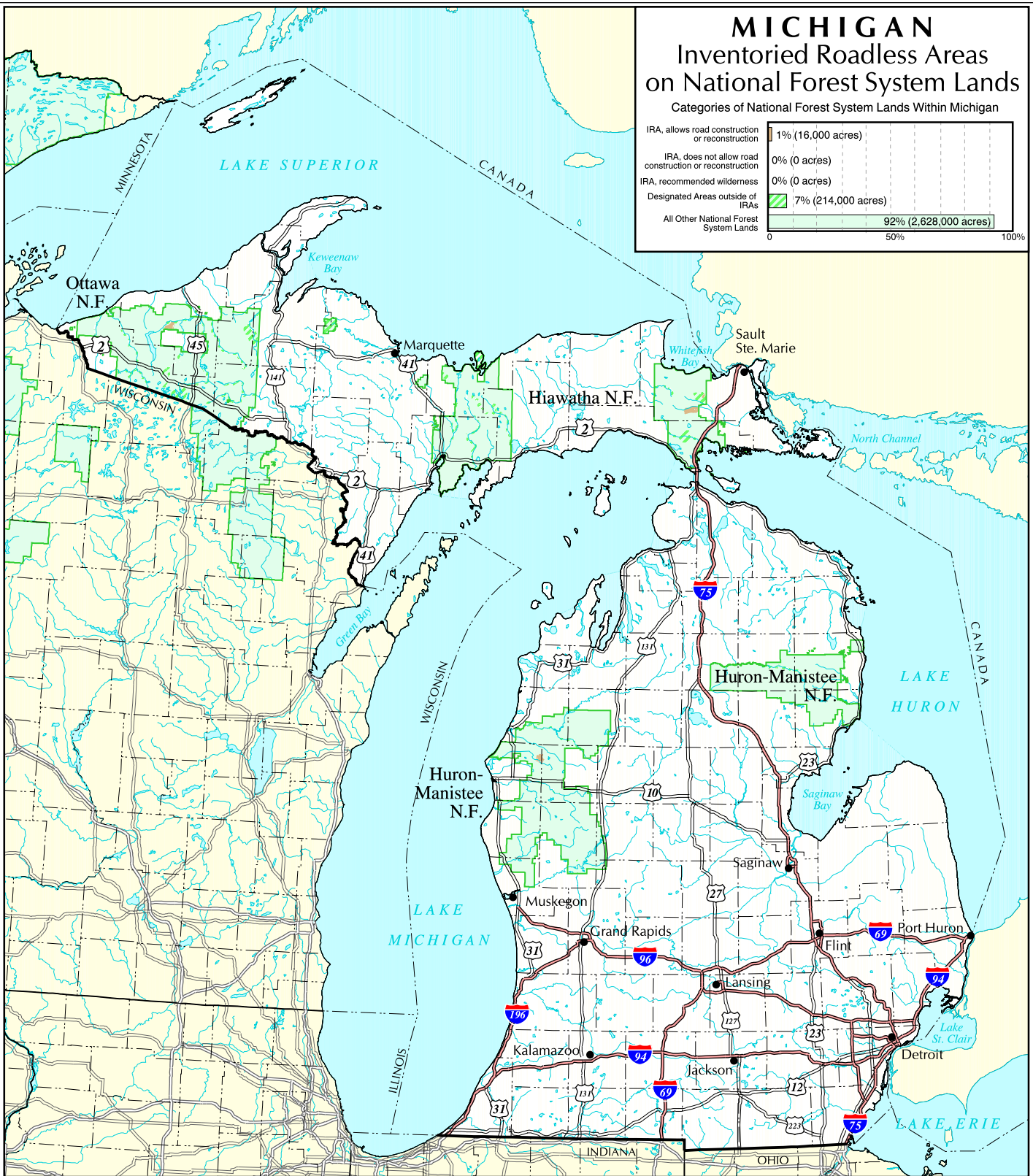

Categories of National Forest System Lands Within Michigan

IRA, allows road construction or reconstruction	1% (16,000 acres)
IRA, does not allow road construction or reconstruction	0% (0 acres)
IRA, recommended wilderness	0% (0 acres)
Designated Areas outside of IRAs	7% (214,000 acres)
All Other National Forest System Lands	92% (2,628,000 acres)
