Computer Security Awareness and Privacy Basics Training for New

Employees

The Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA) or 2002 and Office of Management and Budget guidance requires Computer Security and Awareness Training (CSAT) and privacy training for all employees and contractors.

New employees and contractors are required to take the CSAT and privacy basics training prior to being allowed access to any USDA information systems, sensitive electronic or hard copy data. This training can be provided to these users in either paper-based format or compact disk on a standalone computer. Course completion for these users must be tracked in the AgLearn system as discussed in the November 28, 2007 memorandum from the Chief Information Officer.
