Distribution: Ada, Boise, Elmore, and Gem counties, Idaho.

Habitat: Steep north-facing slopes, often in snow bank areas on moss mats, big sagebrush-Idaho fescue com-

munities and bitterbrush, from 900-1300 m elevation.

Phenology: March through April.

Look-alikes: In vegetative features confused with shooting star (Dodecatheon species), which grows with the Primula, but easily recognized in flower. Similar to if not synonymous with P. cusickiana. Its distinciveness is still guestionable.
