
Densely caespitose perennial 1-2.5 dm tall

Distribution: Western and southern Idaho in Adams, Gooding, Payette, Twin Falls, Owyhee and Washington

counties; e Malheur County, Oregon.

Habitat: Bare soil of ash and clay on open hillsides in the sagebrush-grassland zone, 915-1220 m elevation.

Phenology: April through May.

Look-alikes: Probably close to *C. humilis*, but differing from this species in having green leaves vs gray, finely strigose and appressed-setulose pubescence and the more caespitose habit of *C. humilis*.
