SMUGGLED POULTRY and OTHER AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS increase the

risk of introducing serious agricultural pests and diseases like the most severe form of avian influenza, or "bird flu," into the United States. The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Smuggling Interdiction and Trade Compliance Program needs your help. Some poultry products are **RESTRICTED** and can enter the United States legally under certain conditions,

while others are **PROHIBITED** because of the risk of introducing diseases.
