# 2005 Sheep & Lamb Marketing Policies

### **Scrapie Tags**

**All sheep** sold through the Western Montana Sheep Growers Association, including lambs, ewes, and rams *must have* a scrapie tag. If you have not ordered your *free* tags and applicator, please do so **now**, by calling toll free to (866) 873-2824, or (406) 449-5407. Since, it normally takes about two weeks for delivery we suggest ordering more than one years supply.

Metal tags are stronger and seem to keep their #'s longer.

#### UNTAGGED ANIMALS WILL NOT BE SHIPPED.

Cull sheep must also be tagged. Call in your numbers of culls for sale as early as possible.

#### **Lamb Weights and Numbers**

- Off-type lambs (small framed, thin muscled, hair/wool-less, etc.) will not be mixed into "straight lamb" loads.
- · First load of the season will NOT have a heavy weight limit.
- Lambs sold between June 1 to September 20 lambs must weigh between 80 lbs. and 110 lbs.
- · Call in the number of sheep you are shipping **before** they reach **90 lbs**.(max. wt. is 110 lbs.)
- Be accurate in your count, and deliver only the number of lambs or ewes consigned as load size does <u>NOT</u> allow for extras!

# **Physical Appearance**

- No manure balls on lambs, bucks, or ewes.
- No buck lambs will be taken on "straight lamb" loads (including lambs that were banded but, one or both testicles were missed) ------ but will be accepted on mixed loads.
- No long tails (recommended 1½ inches long) but BUYERS DISCRETION.
- No "Short Docked" tails (recommended 1½ inches long)

#### Health

· No sick or crippled lambs accepted.

## **Horned Sheep**

· Totally at the discretion of the buyer.

# **General Shipping Conditions**

- Sheep must be as dry as possible (can be docked up to 5% for soggy sheep.)
- Do not feed or water sheep within 12 hours of shipping (can be docked up to 4% for fill.)
