2008 Crop Year Additional Price Elections for Actual Production History (APH) Feed Barley and Dry Beans, and Additional Value Price for APH Malting Barley

The additional price election represents the maximum price election for the crop year and specified sales closing date, and is available to producers who insure their 2008 crop at levels above catastrophic coverage. Price election choices must be made on or before the sales closing date for the crop in a county. (For purposes of counties with both winter and spring insurance offers, please reference the applicable crop policy and special provisions of insurance for determining the eligibility for any additional price election.)

Malting Barley –

In accordance with the APH Small Grains Crop Insurance Malting Barley Price and Quality Endorsement, the 2008 CY additional value price under Option A is \$1.50 per bushel.
