	SUBJECT:	Group Risk Plan for Sugarcane Plan of Insurance-Policy and Insurance Documents Release

## **BACKGROUND:**

The Federal Crop Insurance Corporation Board of Directors approved the Group Risk Plan (GRP) for Sugarcane plan of insurance on September 12, 2007. The program is designed to provide insurance benefits comparable to other Federally reinsured group risk plans of insurance.

The GRP-Sugarcane program is available in select counties in Louisiana. GRP-Sugarcane provides coverage to sugarcane producers against substantive reduction in sugarcane yields occurring as a result of unavoidable natural causes. GRP-Sugarcane does not rely on an individual's actual production to determine whether an indemnity is due. Coverage is determined by multiplying the expected risk area yield shown on the actuarial documents by the selected coverage level to determine the trigger yield. If the payment yield published by the Risk Management Agency (RMA) for the insured crop falls below the trigger yield, an indemnity will be paid.

The following are features of GRP-Sugarcane:

- Some counties are grouped into risk areas to establish coverage;
- Catastrophic coverage is not available; and
- Production and price data are determined using National Agricultural Statistics Service data and information from the Farm Service Agency is used to determine planted acres.

Producers interested in GRP-Sugarcane will need to contact a crop insurance agent and complete an application, which will be submitted through the approved insurance provider to RMA. The address of the website is: <u>www.rma.usda.gov/</u>.
