<p>Species Growth Habit Landscaping Appeal Variety (origin)</p>	<p>Little bluestem <i>Schizachyrium scoparium</i> warm-season bunchgrass; 2-4 feet tall fuzzy, white seed when ripe; red fall colors Badlands Ecotype (ND,SD), Itasca (ND,SD,MN) Camper (NE), Blaze (NE)</p>	
<p>Species Growth Habit Landscaping Appeal Variety (origin)</p>	<p>Big bluestem <i>Andropogon gerardii</i> warm-season bunchgrass; 5-7 feet tall seed head resembles a turkey foot; very leafy with a soft texture; reddish fall/winter colors Bonilla (SD), Bison (ND), Sunnyview (SD)</p>	 
<p>Species Growth Habit Landscaping Appeal Variety (origin)</p>	<p>Switchgrass <i>Panicum virgatum</i> warm-season with rhizomes; 3-5 feet tall open panicle seed head with delicate branching and small seeds; golden-yellow fall colors Dacotah (ND), Forestburg (SD), Summer (SD), Sunburst (SD)</p>	
<p>Species Growth Habit Landscaping Appeal Variety (origin)</p>	<p>Indiangrass <i>Sorghastrum nutans</i> warm-season bunchgrass; 4-6 feet tall bronze-colored panicle seed head and softly hairy with bright red flowers Tomahawk(ND, SD), Holt (NE)</p>	 
<p>Species Growth Habit Landscaping Appeal Variety (origin)</p>	<p>Canada wildrye <i>Elymus canadensis</i> cool-season bunchgrass; short-lived; 2-4 feet tall nodding spike seed head with long awns; great fall/winter accent Mandan (ND)</p>
