

Gifts that Change Lives and Institutions Forever

How many times did our parents advise us to plan for the future? "You should keep at least 3 months salary in your savings account just in case something drastic happens and you no longer receive a regular paycheck" are the words of wisdom many new graduates may hear as they enter into the 'real' world.



University endowment funds could be considered the savings account for the future of the institution. Although some institutions such as Princeton and Harvard have recently received tough criticism as to the size of their respective endowment funds and their spending policies with regard to the interest earned through these investments, the University of Kentucky and in particular, the College of Agriculture, strives to increase endowments which provide financial support for students and research.

A fine balance between annual gifts and endowment income helps to provide student scholarships, graduate student fellowships, and funding for extra-curricular activities which enhance the overall student experience. Currently, the University requires a minimum of \$10,000 to endow a fund. An endowment of the minimum size would generate approximately \$500 in available funds for scholarships or travel expenses for competitions or leadership opportunities.

Recently, the College increased the endowment principal for undergraduate scholarships by \$2.4 million through private gifts and matching funds made available through the tobacco settlement match. Although this base principal will grow over time, estimated funds available for scholarships each year is \$120,000. More than 90 endowed scholarships were created or enhanced through this program. These gifts will assist at least 90 students fund their college education. Furthermore, endowed funds are held in perpetuity, changing the lives of an exponential number of students over time.

A cash gift is only one of the options donors have to create an endowed fund. Many of our alumni and friends have established endowment funds through a bequest. Recent bequests from the estates of Janet Koller, John and Betty Heick, and William Norris Duvall established endowments to assist with equine health research, fund the renovation of the E.S. Good Barn, and establish a fund to assist undergraduates participate in leadership training opportunities.

Through the establishment of an endowment, a donor can forever change the face of the institution and offer opportunities to students which may otherwise be impossible. While not meant to replace budget deficits, endowment funds ensure the continuance of scholarships and research activities which prove vitally important to the future of the Commonwealth and to the nation.
