ACTIVITY REPORT OFFICE OF TRUST RECORDS

December 1 - 31, 2006

PROGRAMMATIC:

• Labat-Anderson (Labat Indexing Project)

Labat reported that indexing of 1,140 boxes of inactive Indian records was completed in December 2006. The total number of boxes completed through December 2006 is approximately151,675.

Movement of Records

The Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) and Office of the Special Trustee (OST) moved 2,441 boxes of inactive records from various field locations to Lenexa, Kansas, for indexing and subsequent storage at the American Indian Records Repository (AIRR) during this reporting period.

• Records Retention Schedules

In December 2006, OTR completed development of record retention schedules for the following BIA electronic records systems: Social Services Assistance System, Progeny, Facilities Management Information System, Fee-to-trust, Identity Information System, National Integrated Oil and Gas Electronic Management System, Timber Sales Accounting and Report Program/Operations Inventory, and Colorado River Electrical Utility Management System.

Records retention schedules for the following OST electronic records systems were developed and forwarded to NARA during the last week of December 2006: Risk Management Plus, Trust Beneficiary Call Center, and Lockbox/Trust Funds Receivable Application.

Site Assessments Statement

During the month of December, the Office of Trust Review and Audit issued final records assessment reports for Minnesota Agency, Umatilla Agency, and Crow Creek Agency BIA offices; and Umatilla Agency and Crow Creek Agency IIM offices.

• Records Training

OTR provided records management training for 49 BIA and OST records contacts. OTR inadvertently reported that 18 BIA and OST records contacts were trained in November 2006. The number of records contacts trained was actually

• Equipment

41 pieces of fireproof filing equipment were delivered to tribal offices in December 2006.

Litigation Support and Research Requests

OTR continued to provide significant support to the Office of the Solicitor, Office of Historical Trust Accounting and its contractors, and the Department of Justice and its contractors. AIRR staff provided responses to 216 research requests from BIA, OST and other requesters.
