

346,084 acres in 2002, 321,115 acres in 1997, up 8 percent.

Average size of farm

352 acres in 2002, 312 acres in 1997, up 13 percent.

Market Value of Production

\$39,509,000 in 2002, \$45,121,000 in 1997, down 12 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$16,527,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$22,982,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$40,192 in 2002, \$43,892 in 1997, down 8 percent.


Government Payments
