Crop sales accounted for \$12,308,887 of the total value in 2002.

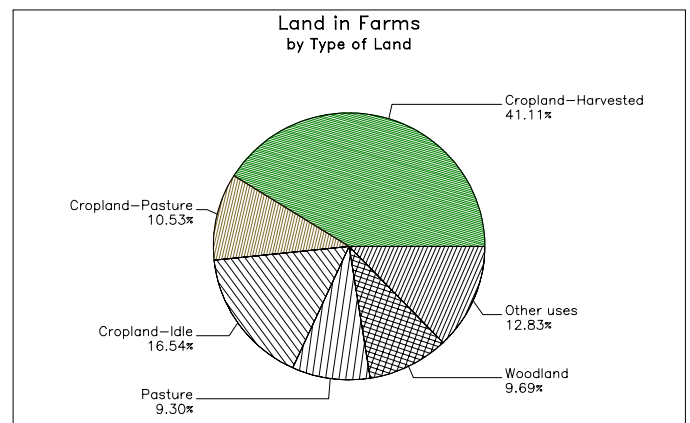
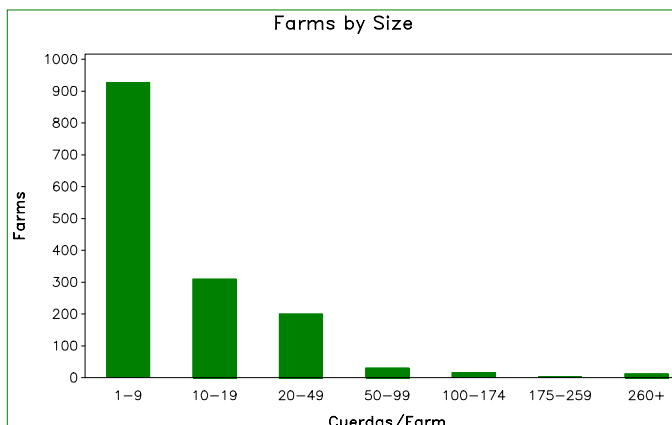
