Crop sales accounted for \$2,906,967 of the total value in 2002.

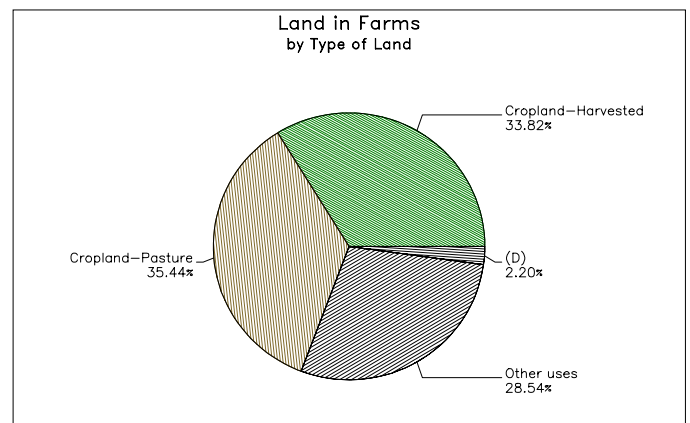
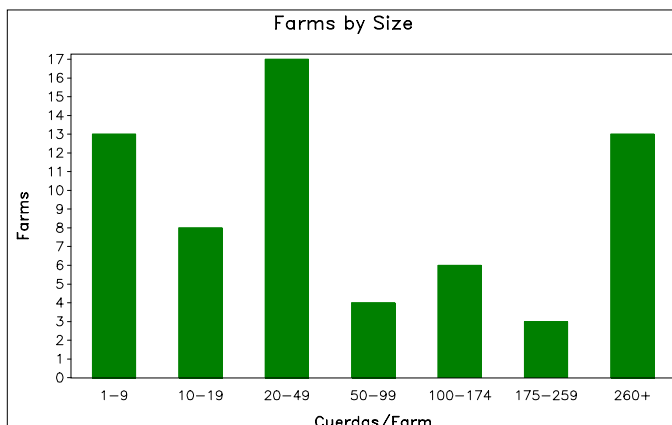
