Crop sales accounted for \$7,026,283 of the total value in 2002.

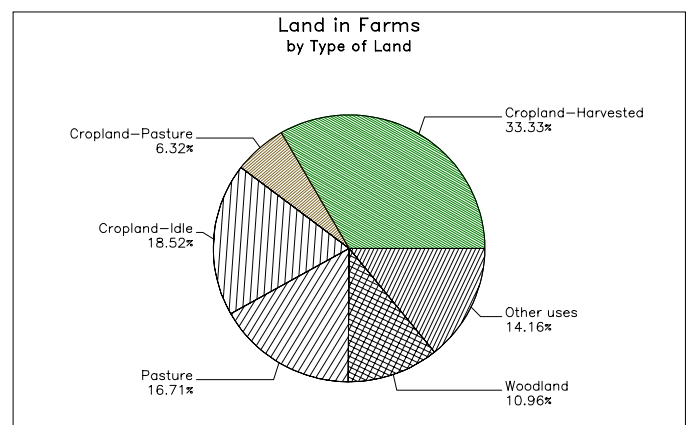
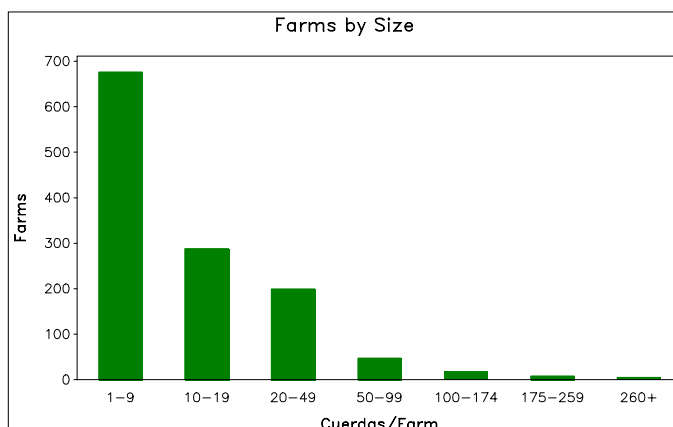
Livestock sales accounted for \$3,680,328 of the total value in 2002.
