Crop sales accounted for \$5,235,793 of the total value in 2002.

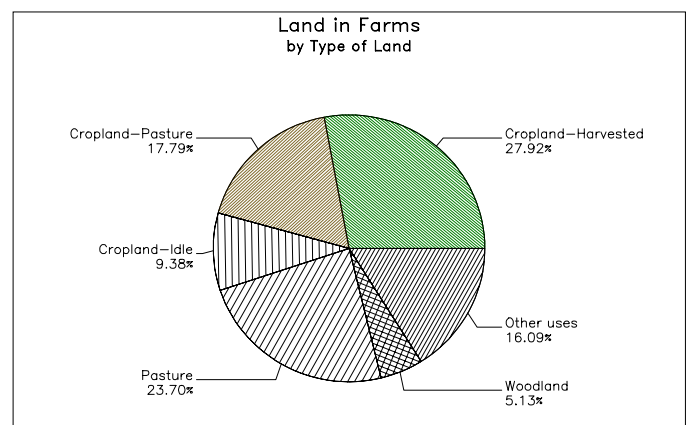
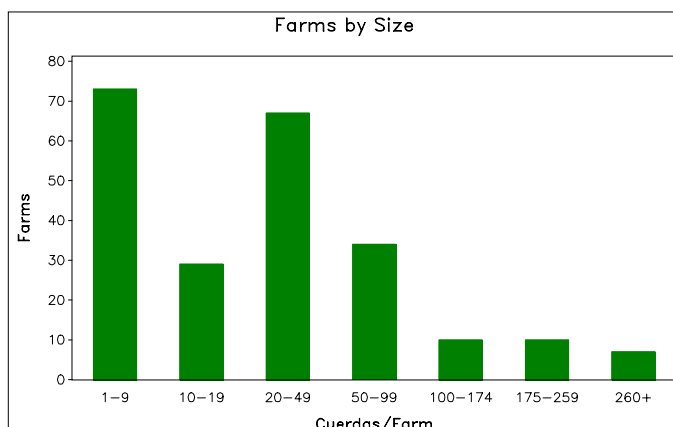
