\$179,321,000 in 2002, \$142,965,000 in 1997, up 25 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$149,050,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$30,271,000 of the total value in 2002.

## Market Value of Production, average per farm




