

\$207,506,000 in 2002, \$233,063,000 in 1997, down 11 percent. Crop sales accounted for \$5,150,000 of the total value in 2002. Livestock sales accounted for \$202,355,000 of the total value in 2002.

Market Value of Production, average per farm


\$163,005 in 2002, \$165,881 in 1997, down 2 percent.


Government Payments
