We would work together to create a scope of work that a person could carry out during his/her time here that would be mutually beneficial to USAID and the sending organization.

The primary objective of the program is to develop institution-to-institution ties on both strategic and implementation levels. Thus, the exchange program is suitable for individuals from a variety of levels and offices within organizations. Similarly, this program also allows for USAID employees to participate in rotations with private sector partners.
