

Web Usage

- As of March 2008, there were 355,500 Internet users in the Palestinian Territories.
- According to the International
 Telecommunications Union
 (ITU), about 14% of the
 population in 2008
 accessed the Internet in the
 Palestinian Territories.
- While the percent of Palestinians with an Internet connection is still low compared to the



Western world, the number is growing rapidly—it almost tripled from 2005 to 2008, going from 5% to 14%.

Health Information

- When the Pew Global Attitudes Project asked about the most important problems facing their families today in their survey, almost all of the countries sampled chose economic concerns more than health-related concerns (2007). However, 10% of Palestinians ranked health as one of their most pressing concerns.
- Likewise, the issues cited as being very big problems included terrorism, illegal drugs, crime, pollution, and spread of HIV and other infectious diseases.

Corrupt leaders 73%

Crime 68%

Illegal drugs 66%

Pollution 56%

Terrorism 51%

Mobile

- In 2007, Pew reported that 68% of adults own mobile phones in the Palestinian Territories (see table in Israel mobile section below).
- The ITU reported that phone use has grown dramatically from 2002 to 2007—with a 26% increase.
- Mobile phones account for three-quarters of all telephone subscriptions in the Palestinian Territories.
