**WASHINGTON** – Small business owners from across the country will be honored for their accomplishments as the nation's leading small businesses at *National Small Business Week* events April 21-25, 2008, in Washington, D.C., and New York City. A highlight of events will be the announcement of the *National Small Business Person of the Year* April 22.
