- Providing incentives to use public transportation by supporting H.R. 6052, the Saving Energy Through Public Transportation Act of 2008

REDUCING GAS PRICES

Bilbray is working for solutions

Congressman Bilbray understands that high gas prices are affecting every family. He is working on short-term and long-term solutions aimed at lowering gas prices and addressing our future energy needs. In Congress, Brian Bilbray:

- Voted to pass H.R. 6022 which will increase the oil supply by temporarily suspending oil shipments to the Strategic Petroleum Reserve
- Voted to pass H.R. 6346, bipartisan legislation that defines price gouging and authorizes the federal government to investigate and penalize companies suspected of doing so
