General Comment: The proposed regulation to make lists of retailers available to the public, during a meat or poultry, recall is a big step in the right direction for the FSIS. It is a basic right of consumers to know where recalled meat has been sold and it is a responsibility of the US government, through the FSIS, to provide that information. It would be useful to consumers if the information on sources of recalled meat/poultry were broadcast on the radio and TV and listed in the newspaper as a public service announcement. There is no downside to this requirement--it can only help to protect the safety and health of the public.
