Dear Dr. Masters:

The United Egg Producers (UEP) and United Egg Association (UEA) Further Processor Division are requesting an extension of the comment period on Docket Number 04-034N "Salmonella Enteritidis in Shell Eggs and Salmonella spp. in Liquid Egg Products Risk Assessments."

The October 5, 2004, notice of public meeting and availability of draft risk assessments requested comments on the draft documents by November 15, 2004. We are requesting an extension of this date to provide a 90-day comment period. These risk assessments are extremely important to the egg and egg products industries. As stated in the October 5 notice, the Food Safety and Inspection Service will use the scientific information provided in them to develop pathogen reduction lethality performance standards that the Agency intends to propose for pasteurized shell eggs and pasteurized egg products. In light of our mutual desire to assure the safety of eggs and egg products, we believe sufficient time should be provided for the industry and others to perform a careful scientific review of the risk assessments.

With over 210 pages in the text of the risk assessment and an additional 382 pages in the annex section, it will take a significant amount of time and industry effort to respond to the data and estimates provided. None of these documents were available before October 18, while annexes B, C, D, E, G, H and I were only available the week of October 25 and Annex F is not yet available. Therefore, the Agency has not provided an adequate or reasonable opportunity for public comment. In addition, it would be helpful if the FSIS national baseline

survey to measure Salmonella levels in liquid egg products produced in the United States were available publicly for review during the comment period, but such is not the case.

UEP and UEA also request that FDA's comments and any outstanding comments from peer reviewers be incorporated into the documents before the end of the public comment period. We believe that it is important for the industry to review the documents again after those changes are made. Again, if this does not occur, it seems that a reasonable opportunity for public comment has not been afforded.

Thank you for your consideration of our request for an extension of the comment period.
