Agricultural Research Service (ARS)

ARS is the designated contracting activity for the Research, Education, and Economics (REE) mission area agencies: Cooperative State Research, Education, and Extension Service (CSREES), Economic Research Service (ERS), and National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS). In support of these agencies, ARS procures a variety of supplies, services, and equipment. In addition, ARS procures major construction services such as small buildings, greenhouses, repair, maintenance, and energy retrofitting.

ARS develops through basic, applied, and developmental research, new knowledge and technology which will ensure an abundance of high quality, nutritious, and reasonably priced food and other agricultural products to meet domestic and world needs while maintaining natural resources and environmental quality. ARS provides access to agricultural information, develops new knowledge and technology to solve technical agricultural problems, and sustains a viable and competitive food and agricultural economy.

Purchasing is accomplished at the lowest level possible in over 100 decentralized locations throughout the United States to maintain operational support close to the mission activity units. Most items and services are purchased through the competitive bidding process (i.e., sealed bids or negotiated procurements), which may be set-aside for Small, HUBZone or Very Small businesses. Federal Supply Schedule and Governmentwide Acquisition contracts are also significant sources of supplies.

Cooperative State Research, Education, and Extension Service (CSREES)

The goal of CSREES is to strengthen Federal, State, and local partnerships in research, education, and extension activities. CSREES facilitates the advancement of science and technology in the nationwide agricultural research system by providing Federal resources, participating in cooperative program planning and evaluation, including development of a forum for coordinating between State Agricultural Experiment Stations, USDA, and Federal research scientists. CSREES responds educationally to critical national issues affecting food and agricultural systems.

National Agricultural Statistic Service (NASS)

The National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) gives coordinated leadership to statistical reporting, research, and service programs of USDA. It provides a channel for the orderly flow of statistical intelligence about the agricultural economy and the country. The primary responsibilities of NASS are the crop and livestock estimates (national and state) including coordination and improvement in USDA's statistical requirements.

Economic Research Service (ERS)

The Economic Research Service (ERS) develops and carries out a program of economic research designed to benefit farmers and the general public. The findings of this research are made available to farmers and others through research reports and economic outlook and situation reports on major commodities, and the national and international economies.
