Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Montana reported 7 cases in 2005.
- RATES: Montana ranked 43 among 50 states + DC + 3 territories: 0.8 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 3.0 cases per 100,000 population.

Male-female rates of primary and secondary syphilis

- In Montana, the rate among males was 1.3 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 5.1 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.2 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9 per 100,000.

Racial disparities of primary and secondary syphllis


In Montana, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.7 among whites, 0.0 among blacks, 4.6 among Hispanics, 0.0 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.

 The rate among Hispanics was 6.6 times that of whites.

Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Montana reported 0 cases in 2005.
- RATES: Montana had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.0 cases per 100,000.
