Nevada, 2005

Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: Nevada reported 109 cases in 2005.
- RATES: Nevada ranked 6 among 50 states + DC + 3 territories: 4.7 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 3.0 cases per 100,000 population.

Male-female rates of primary and secondary syphilis

- In Nevada, the rate among males was 7.2 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 5.1 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 2.1 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9 per 100,000.

Racial disparities of primary and secondary syphllis


In Nevada, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 3.6 among whites, 18.8 among blacks, 3.4 among Hispanics, 4.1 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.

- The rate among blacks was 5.2 times that of whites.
- The rate among Asian/Pacific Islanders was 1.1 times that of whites.

Congenital syphilis

- CASES: Nevada reported 1 case in 2005.
- RATES: Nevada ranked 21 among 28 states + 2 territories reporting at least one congenital syphilis case: 3.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.0 cases per 100,000.
