South Dakota, 2005

Primary and secondary syphilis

- CASES: South Dakota reported 2 cases in 2005.
- RATES: South Dakota ranked 48 among 50 states + DC + 3 territories: 0.3 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 3.0 cases per 100,000 population.

Male-female rates of primary and secondary syphilis

- In South Dakota, the rate among males was 0.5 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 5.1 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.0 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9 per 100,000.

Racial disparities of primary and secondary syphllis


In South Dakota, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.1 among whites, 14.2 among blacks, 0.0 among Hispanics, 0.0 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.

• The rate among blacks was 142 times that of whites.


Congenital syphilis

- CASES: South Dakota reported 0 cases in 2005.
- RATES: South Dakota had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.0 cases per 100,000.
