Rick Carpenter provided a status report on the City of Santa Fe Water Supply Program (see attached presentation).

The Council viewed the Los Alamos National Laboratory Water Research Technical Assistance Office showing of "Agua es Vida" (Groundwater and Sustainability). The video examines groundwater hydrology and sustainability, using the Espanola Basin in northern New Mexico to illustrate water resource issues typical of arid and semi-arid regions of the world. It explains the scientific principles of hydrology that are applicable to the determination of water availability and the management of groundwater resources. The new 45-minute film was produced by the Laboratory's Groundwater Protection Program in FY 04.
