Update on Landscapes and Watersheds workshop

Paul Paryski provided the most recent draft of the workshop outline and recommendations. The legality of modifying landscapes for water harvesting will be a major issue for this workshop. Ideas for organization of the recommendations for decisionmakers included grouping by implementing entity, time frame, and zone (urban, rural, etc.).

Topics discussed included potential case studies and available research, the need to tailor approaches to water harvesting for specific locations, and the need to support research to develop models of evapotranspiration, runoff, and infiltration.
