## Notes:

- If a team is unavailable, they will be skipped in the rotation and the next team will be available for that date period. The unavailable team will move to the end team position.
- If an IMT gets assigned to an incident and completes transfer of command, the rotation will move to the next IMT even if the assignment is short in duration. If the IMT does not officially take command, they will retain their slot in the rotation.
- If major imbalances in assignments develop, rotation may be modified, (SWCC and SWCG).
- The Type 2 rotation procedures are a guide and may be amended at the discretion of the SWCG. Since these procedures cannot cover every potential situation, interpretation by the SWCC Center Manager/SWCG may be required.
