This bulletin changes mileage rates for advantageous use of a Privately-Owned Vehicle effective for travel on and after September 1, 2005.

The General Services Administration has issued a change to the Federal Travel Regulation, dated September 13, 2005, to increase the mileage reimbursement rate for advantageous use of privately owned vehicles, **effective for travel on or after September 1, 2005.**

Automobile	<b>40.5 cents</b>	<b>48.5 cents</b>
Airplane	<b>No change</b>	<b>(Remains at \$1.07)</b>
Motorcycle	<b>No change</b>	<b>(Remains at 30.5 cents)</b>

When an employee chooses to drive his/her privately owned automobile although a Government Owned Vehicle (GOV) is available, the mileage rate of **28.5 cents has not changed.** The **10.5 cent mileage rate** for those employees committed or assigned a GOV that choose to use their privately owned automobile **has not changed.**

Mileage rates for Transfer of Station en route travel have not changed.
