BUTTE

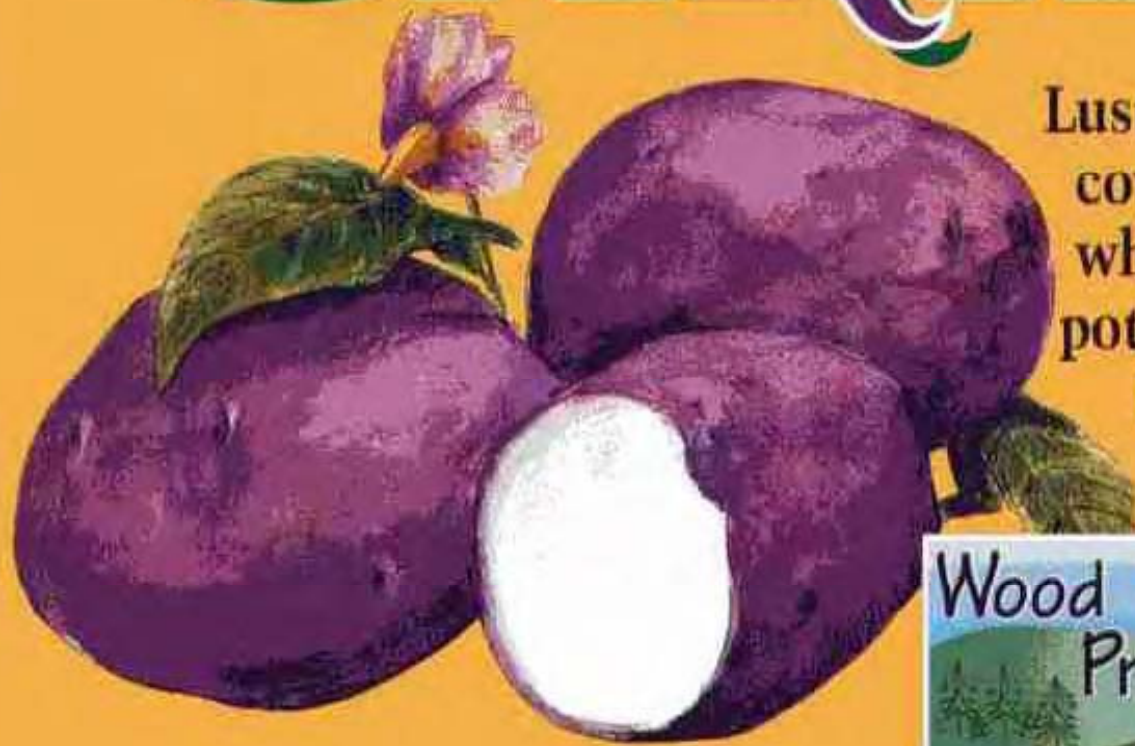


Handsome russet baker with outstanding flavor. Highest in Vitamin C and protein. Great baked, mashed, or fried.

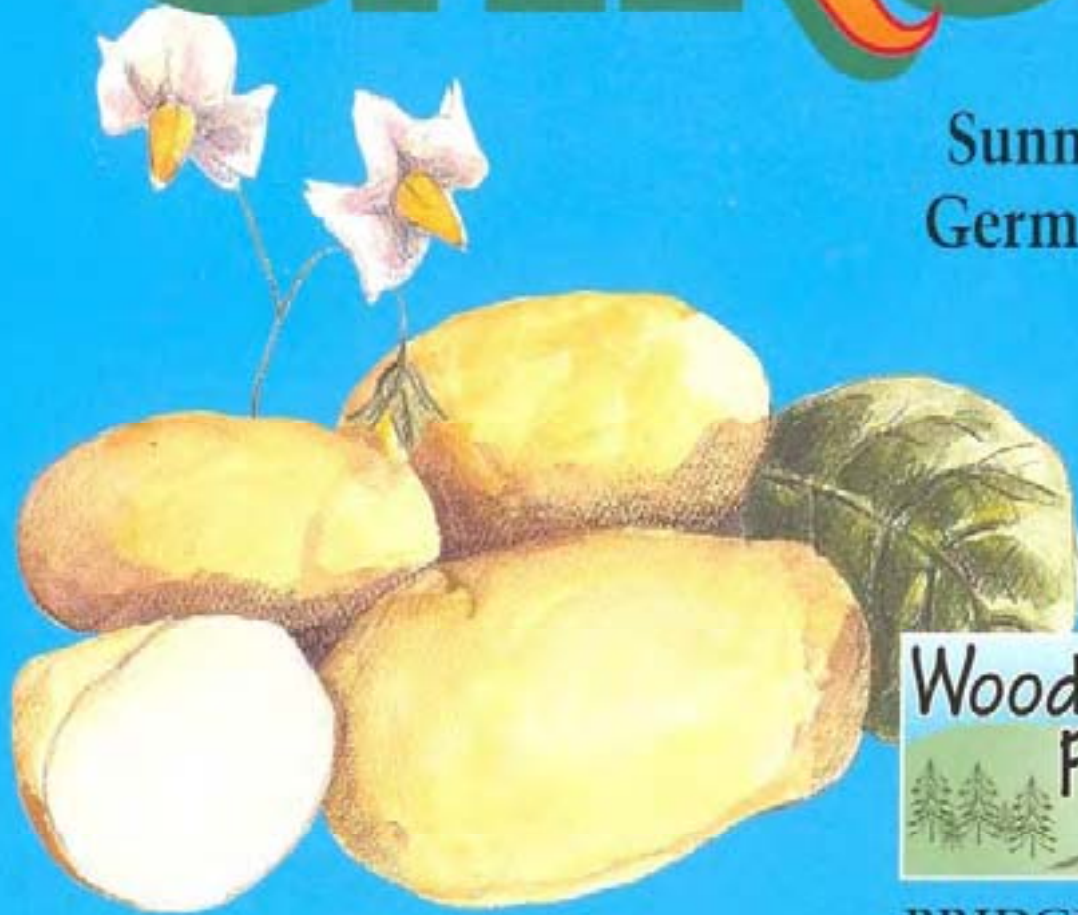


Lustrous purple skin covers smooth snow-white flesh. A great potato for boiling, baking, or frying.

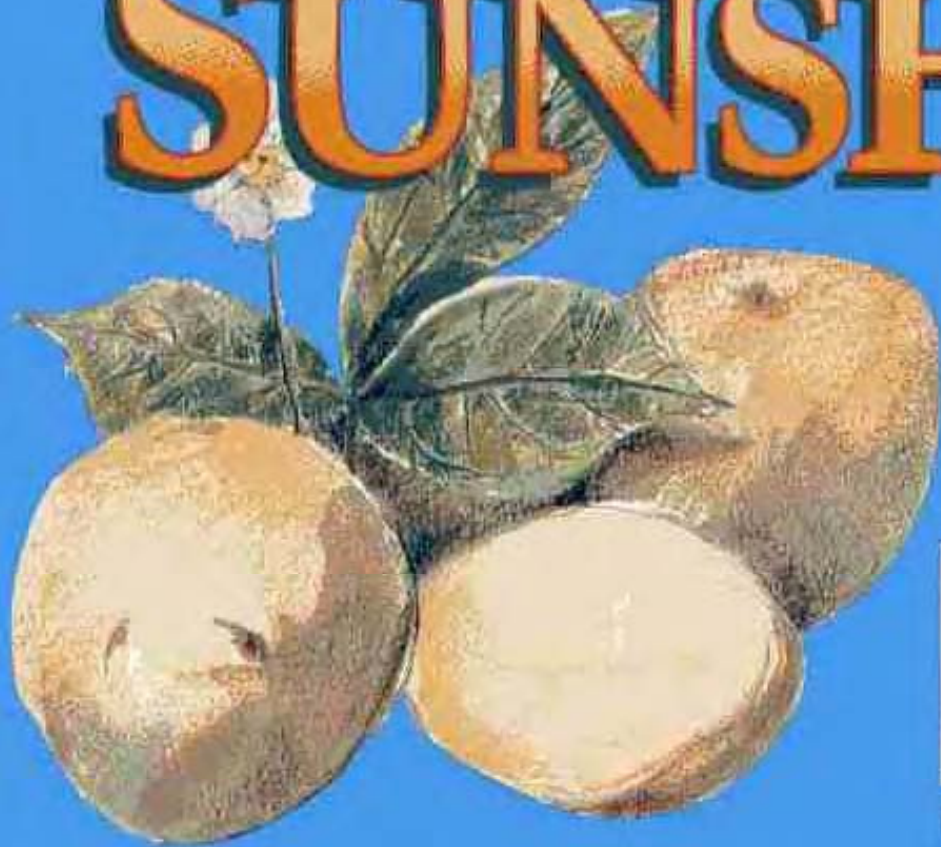
KING HARRY

ROSE FINN APPLE FINGERLING

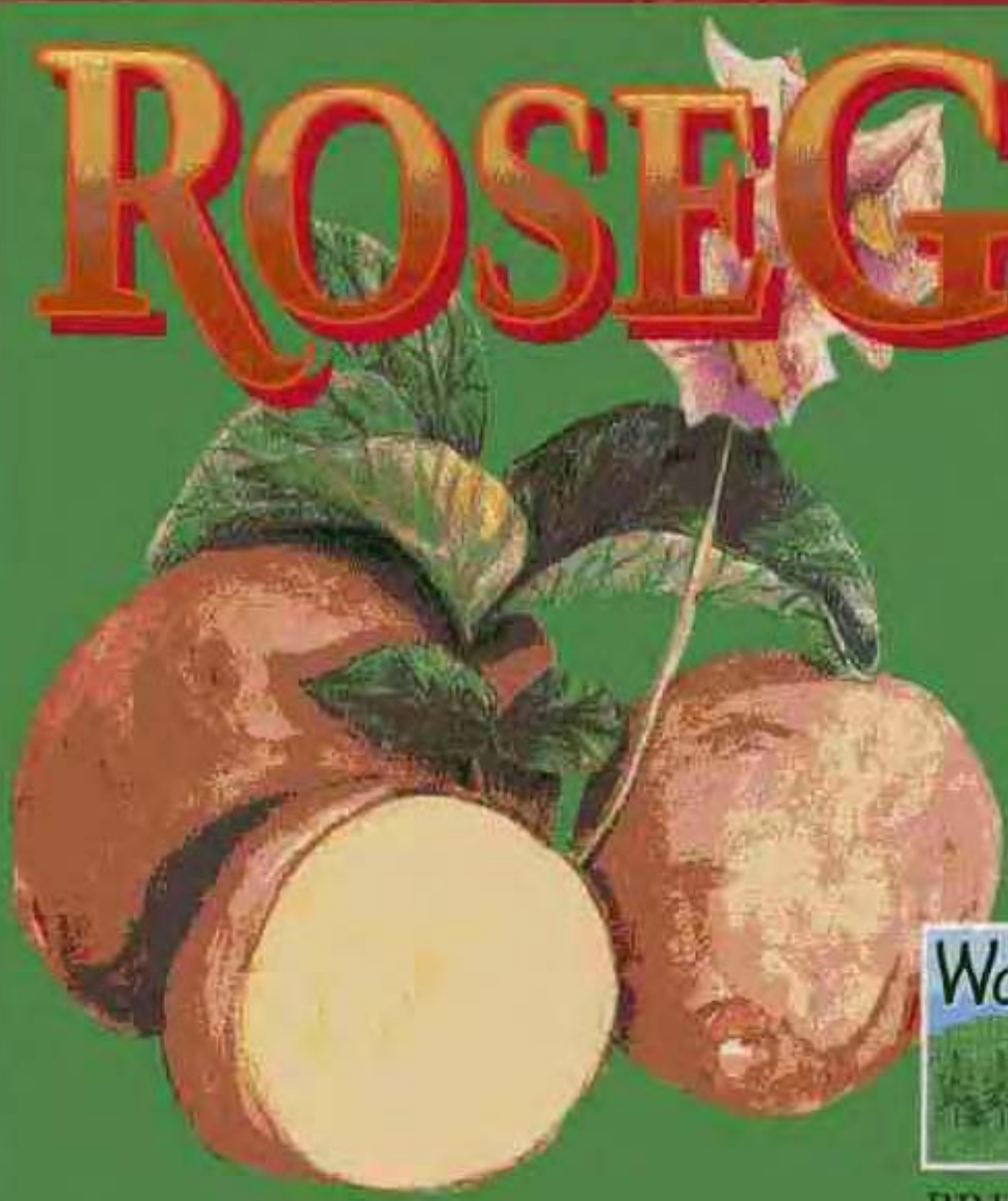


Rare and beautiful rosy-colored

RUSSIAN BANANA FINGERLING

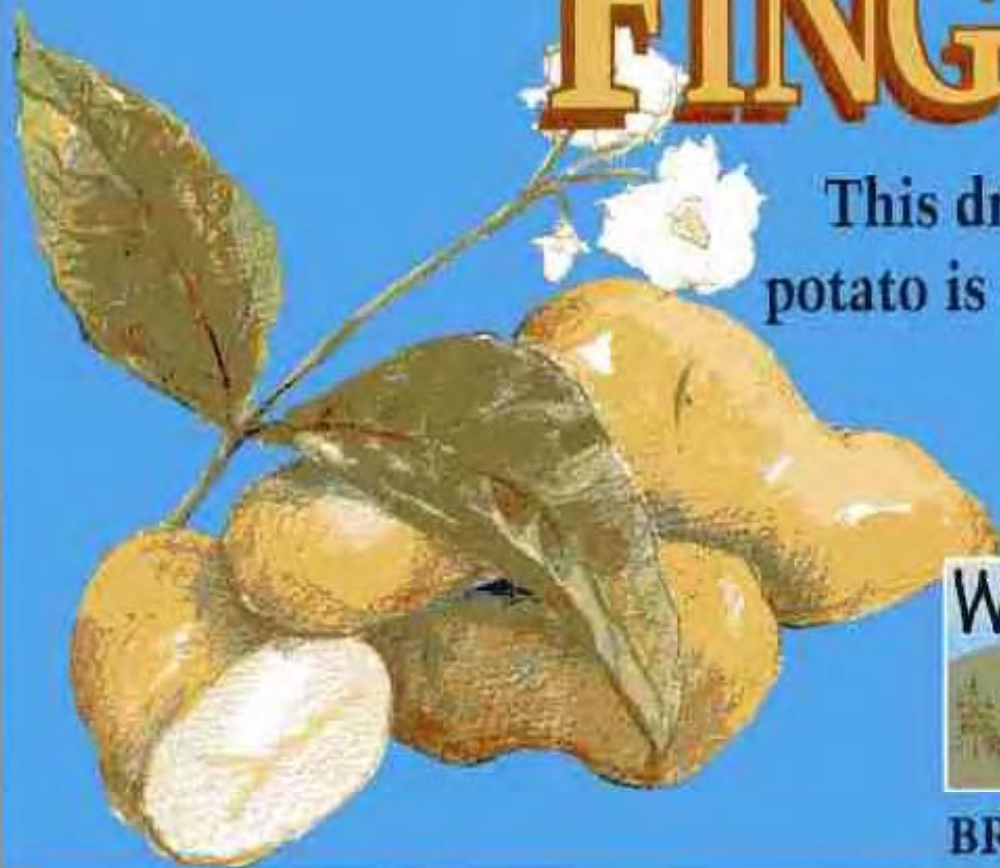


Rare heirloom potato. Savory finger-sized yellow tubers are exquisite baked, boiled, or in salads.

SWEDISH PEANUT FINGERLING

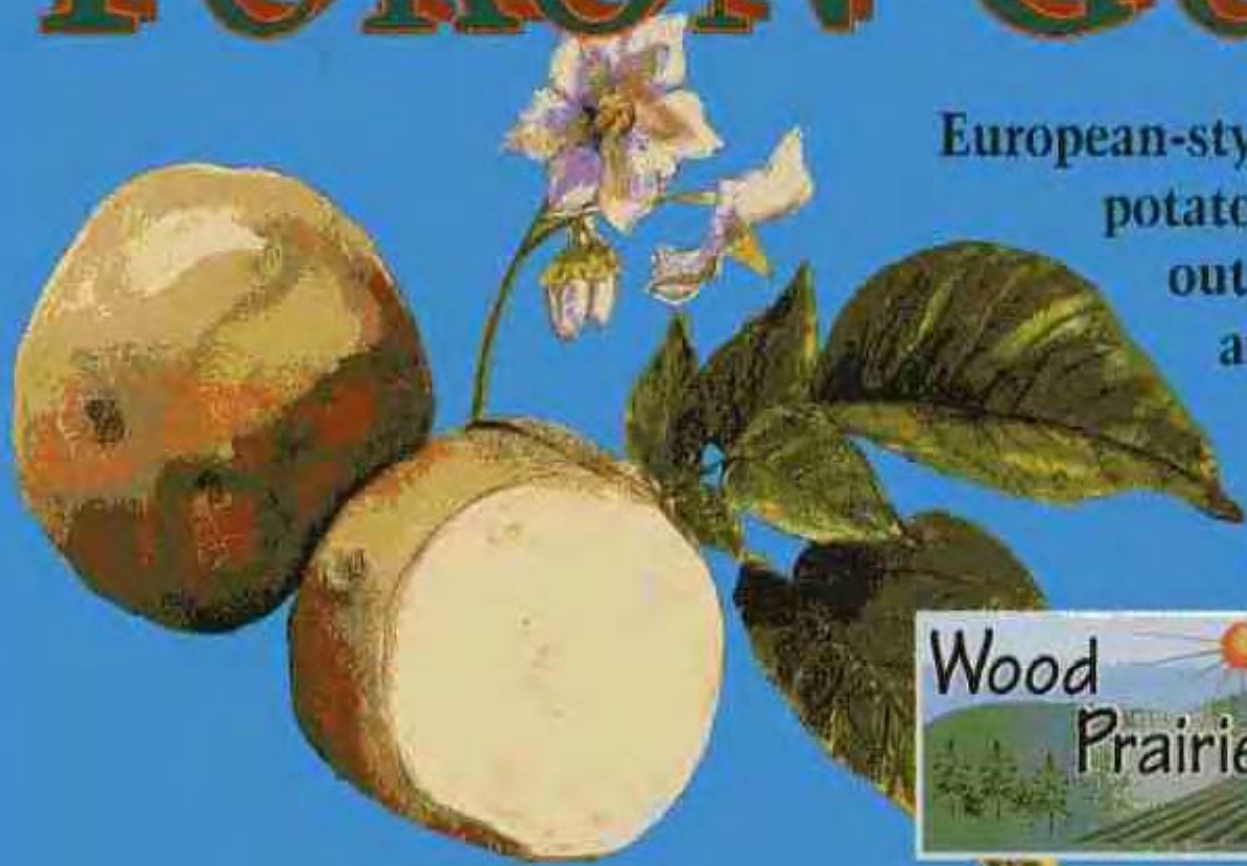


This dry golden-fleshed fingerling potato is the heirloom from Sweden also known as Mandel. Perfect baked or roasted.
