

Cherry Stewardship Timber Sale

DXSpa is defined as Designation by Spacing. Separate subdivisions, 1(a-c), have added prescriptions along with the Designation by Spacing while subdivision 1(d) exclusively follows the heavy thin prescription which are described below.

- 32 acres of the stand (unit 1) will exclusively follow the Designation by Spacing prescription in which all live conifers (except for Western Larch, Western White Pine and Ponderosa Pine) 9"-25" in stump diameter will be cut within 24 feet of a live conifer with a larger stump diameter (Douglas-Fir will be preferred for retention).
- Approximately 5 acres, subdivisions 1(a-c), will contain a variable density thinning prescription in which gaps will be created by cutting all Grand Fir trees less than 25" stump diameter while retaining all Douglas-Fir, Western Larch, Western White Pine and Ponderosa Pine. The remainder of the subdivisions 1(a-c) will be cut using the Designation by Spacing prescription.
- The remaining subdivision 1(d), approximately 5 acres, will utilize the heavy thin prescription in which all live conifers (except for Western Larch, Western White Pine and Ponderosa Pine) 9"-25" in stump diameter will be cut within 21 feet of live conifer with a larger stump diameter (Douglas-Fir will be preferred for retention).
