The Office of the Federal Environmental Executive is pleased to announce the recipients of the 2007 White House Closing the Circle (CTC) Awards. The CTC Awards recognize outstanding achievements of Federal employees and their facilities for efforts that resulted in significant contributions to, or have made a significant positive impact regarding to environmental stewardship. The awards focus on waste prevention, recycling, and green purchasing activities, environmental management, green/sustainable buildings, electronics stewardship, and reduced fuel usage. This year the program also includes three special "Sowing the Seeds" awards issued by the Federal Environmental Executive that recognize leadership in setting future vision.

"As reflected in the new Executive Order, *13423 Strengthening Federal Environmental, Energy, and Transportation Management*, the government continues on an aggressive path towards sustainable environmental performance," said Mr. Ed Piñero, the Federal Environmental Executive.
