FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL EXECUTIVE AND EPA HONOR FEDERAL ELECTRONICS STEWARDSHIP EFFORTS

The Office of the Federal Environmental Executive and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency are pleased to announce the recipients of the 2008 Federal Electronics Challenge (FEC) Awards. The 2008 FEC Awards recognize the achievements of FEC partners and their leadership in federal electronics stewardship during 2007.

For 2008, the FEC is recognizing two Gold Level Award recipients: the Department of Homeland Security's Transportation Security Administration and the Environmental Protection Agency's Region 8. Each Gold Level Award recipient completed mandatory activities in all three of the electronics life-cycle phases (acquisition and procurement, operation and maintenance, and end-of-life management); completed nine additional optional activities; and mentored other Federal facilities or agencies on electronics issues. The FEC is also recognizing 10 Silver Level Award recipients, who each completed mandatory activities in 2 of 3 of the electronics life-cycle phases and 6 additional optional activities; and 18 Bronze Level Award recipients, who each completed mandatory activities in 1 of 3 of the electronics life-cycle phases and 3 additional optional activities.

The FEC will also be recognizing 6 Federal agencies for their assistance with the transition to the new FEC partnership structure in 2007, as well as all of the individuals that acted as FEC Champions during 2007. FEC Champions are representatives from the Environmental Protection Agency who are available to assist regional Federal facilities with their electronics stewardship programs.

The 2008 FEC Award recipients will be recognized at a ceremony during the 7th Annual Federal Environmental Symposium, in Bethesda, MD on June 4, 2008, and at a ceremony during the 1st Federal Environmental Symposium - West in Big Sky, MT on June 18, 2008.

The FEC is a partnership program that encourages Federal facilities and agencies to: purchase greener electronic products; reduce impacts of electronic products during use; and manage obsolete electronics in an environmentally safe way. The FEC assists Federal facilities and agencies to become leaders and face the challenges posed by life cycle management of electronics.
