A General Guide: HOW to EVALUATE final Rank for a WMA Superior, Good, Adequate, Needs Improvement

5 points	MOU: Is it current? Are appropriate organizations included?
5 points	Meetings: Are they happening regularly? How many organizations are participating? Is there an active chair?
5 points	Outreach: What materials and strategies have been developed? How successful are they?
20 pts	Strategic plan: How recently has it been revisited? Does it provide adequate strategic direction? What will base funding be used for?
15 pts	Mapping and inventory: What level of info is there on top weeds? Is more info being actively gathered? Is spatial info used to strategically select projects?
25 pts	Management: Have projects been well defined and strategic (tying to strategic plan)? Have they accomplished goals? How is follow up? Have they engaged many partners?
25 pts	Monitoring: How effectively are things tracked, including on-the- ground projects, mapping, outreach, in-kind hours, etc.

WMA "Rank":

Superior- 90 to 100 points

Good-80 to 89 points

Adequate- 65 to 79 points

Needs Improvement- Lower than 65 points
