



**Minimum Qualifications:**

- A. Bachelors Degree from an accredited college or university in counseling, psychology, or a related field, plus at least two years of experience in substance abuse counseling or a combination of formal college course work and experience totaling five years. .**
- B. Applicants must be Nevada State certified (BADA) or be able to qualify for at least a provisional state certification as an Alcohol or Substance Abuse Counselor and become certified within one year of employment.**
- C. Be able to develop and maintain a good working relationship with clients and staff and be able to meet and deal with community pressures for the position. Must maintain strict confidentiality.**
- D. Knowledge of racial, ethnic, cultural values and attitudes for the service population.**
- E. Must have a valid Nevada driver's license.**
- F. Must have a proven record of sobriety prior to and during employment as SAB Counselor.**
- G. Must be able to pass a background test pursuant to Public Law 1cl-630 se.408(b). Must be willing to work evenings and weekends as required.**
- H. Preference to qualified Indians will be given.**
