

Pacific Northwest NATIVE PLANT SALE

A NATIVE PLANT CAN BE DEFINED broadly by the habitat in which it grows. Much of the original habitat once found in the Pacific Northwest has been lost, especially in cities where the rainforest has been removed and replaced by buildings and streets. Habitat can be restored to some extent with native plants but care must be taken to ensure they are grown in the proper conditions. Rainforest plants often require some shade and moderate to high soil moisture; for more sunny, exposed areas with drier soils, plants typical of more open forests or the rainforest shadow on Vancouver Island and the Gulf Islands can be grown. Plants from the interior of the province or from higher elevations may have unique requirements, though many are adaptable to urban conditions. For more information on gardening with native plants, talk to the Native Plant Society or to the nursery owners in the plant sales area.

Some Things to Think About When Gardening with Native Plants:

- The mature size of the plant
- The elevation: lowland to mountain
- The exposure: full sun, partial shade, shade
- The soil moisture: dry to moist to wet
- The slope/drainage and soil texture: water receiving or shedding; organic to mineral
- The soil nutrients: nitrogen poor, medium, rich
- The soil acidity: acid (most) or alkaline
