JUSTICE STEVENS, concurring in part and dissenting in part.

As I explain in my dissent in *Wilson* v. *Layne*, *ante* at _____, I am convinced that the constitutional rule recognized in that case had been clearly established long before 1992. I therefore respectfully dissent from the Court's disposition of this case on qualified immunity grounds.
