Common State EOP Functions

Federal Emergency Support Functions

Direction and Control

- ★ Describes the method used to facilitate round-the-clock policy making, coordination, and control of the organizations involved in response operations.
- ★ Describes the policies, roles, and responsibilities of the organizations that perform core *life-saving* ...

...and recovery functions.

★ Describes relationships of responding State personnel with Federal response force personnel.

ESF-5 Information and Planning

- During early part of the response, personnel may be located in the State EOC.
- ★ ERT-N, ERT-A, FAST, EST.

ESF-4 Firefighting

- ★ Provides personnel, equipment, and supplies to support States involved in rural, wild land, and urban firefighting operations.
- ★ Provides fire-weather forecasting.
- ★ Provides urban and industrial fire hazard analysis.
- ★ Provides limited radio communications for use of responding firefighting groups when no common radio frequency is available.

ESF-9 Urban Search and Rescue

★ Coordinates with State officials on the requirements for Urban Search and Rescue support.

ESF-10 Hazardous Materials

★ Supports State/local response to a HAZMAT incident.

ESF-3 Public Works and Engineering

Upon request by the State, provides for:

- ★ Emergency removal of debris.
- ★ Temporary construction of emergency access routes.
- ★ Emergency restoration of critical public services and facilities.
- ★ Emergency demolition or stabilization of damaged structures designated as immediate hazards to the public health and safety, or as necessary to facilitate lifesaving operations.
- **★** Technical assistance for damage assessment.

ESF-12 Energy

- ★ Coordinates with State officials to establish priorities to repair damaged energy systems.
- ★ Coordinates providing temporary, alternate, or interim sources of emergency fuel and power.
- ★ Assists State Coordinating Officer in establishing priorities to repair damage to energy systems.

Regional Response Plans (RRPs) address State/Federal interface issues.
