- Compliance with:
 - Executive Order 13148 Greening the Government Through Leadership in Environmental Management
 - Compliance with ISO 14001 Environmental Management System Standards
 - DOC EMS Policy (April 22, 2003) and Environmental Management Manual



Agency Requirements



- Annually Agencies must place high priority on obtaining funding and resources needed to implement EO 13148 (*Circular A-11, Section 31.2*)
- Each agency shall implement environmental management systems (EMS) through pilot projects at selected agency facilities
- By December 31, 2005, each agency shall implement an EMS at all <u>appropriate</u> agency facilities based on facility size, complexity, and the environmental aspects of facility operations.
 - The facility EMS shall include measurable environmental goals, objectives, and targets that are reviewed and updated annually.
- Once established, EMS performance measures shall be incorporated in agency facility audit protocols.
