Community Advisory Board for Nevada Test Site Programs Public Meeting

A public meeting hosted by the Community Advisory Board (CAB) for the Nevada Test Site (NTS) programs will take place from 6 – 8:30 p.m., Wednesday, September 8, 2004, at the Bob Ruud Community Center, 150 N. Highway 160, in Pahrump, Nevada. The meeting will include a briefing by the CAB's Underground Test Area Committee to update stakeholders on their work related to the groundwater at the NTS. In addition, the U.S. Department of Energy Nevada Site Office Environmental Management (EM) Program will provide a status report on shipments of transuranic waste from the NTS to the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) near Carlsbad, New Mexico.

The CAB is comprised of volunteer citizens who provide the U.S. Department of Energy Nevada Site Office's EM Program with informed recommendations on environmental activities at the Nevada Test Site. The CAB sponsors quarterly public meetings and is chartered under the U.S. Department of Energy's Environmental Management Site Specific Advisory Board.
