NNSA/NSO Launches New Internet Site

The National Nuclear Security Administration Nevada Site Office (NNSA/NSO) launched a completely redesigned Internet Website. The new site, located at http://www.nv.doe.gov, is arranged into six main sections: National Security, Environmental Programs, Nevada Test Site, Library, About NSO and Kids Zone. More than 1,400 photographs, 95 films, and hundreds of documents and publications are featured on the site.

"Giving the public access to information and keeping them aware of our operations is critical to the success of the Nevada Site Office," said Kathleen Carlson, NNSA/NSO Manager. "This new site helps us reach an expanded audience and educate them about our programs and activities."

More than a year of planning, designing, building and implementation went into the site prior to it going live. Some of the advanced features of the new site include electronic request forms, updated questions and answers, and an in-depth "Help" section.

An ongoing exchange of information and ideas with the public is one of the primary goals of the Nevada Site Office. Some of the ways the public can participate include becoming involved in the Community Advisory Board, taking a Nevada Test Site tour, calling on the Speakers Bureau, and visiting the Public Reading Facility.
