This standard was specially purified at the National Bureau of Standards for use in checking microdeterminations of carbon, hydrogen, sulfur, and nitrogen. The absolute purity of the standard has not been established as yet, but microanalytical determinations have yielded values that check the theoretical composition within the limits of experimental error. It is therefore recommended that the theoretical percentages be used, namely:

Carbon 29.99
Hydrogen 5.03
Sulfur 26.68
Nitrogen 11.66
