Welcome to the 2007-2008 Tilth Producers Directory, a guide to Washington's organic and sustainable agricultural community. This directory lists agricultural products and services produced organically or sustainably in Washington State. The farms and businesses listed in this directory are members of Tilth Producers of Washington, the only statewide member organization of Washington Tilth Association.

Tilth Producers of Washington works through education, networking and research to promote ecologically sound, economically viable and socially equitable farming practices that improve the health of our communities and natural environment. While this directory does not include all the organic growers and businesses in the state, it is the most comprehensive list available.

Grower Listings

Growers are listed by region to help directory users connect with nearby farmers. Regions are outlined on page 1. Growers may produce some crops and value-added products not listed here; please ask growers for specific crops.

Symbols Used to Identify Organic Practices

This directory includes growers using a wide variety of growing practices. Farmers reported their growing practices in their directory application forms. Tilth Producers does not guarantee the certification of any farmer. We encourage directory users to ask growers about their farming practices. Growing practices are:

☑ Certified Organic

These growers have been certified by the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA), or another certification agency accredited by the

USDA, for compliance with the laws defining "organically grown."

☆ Not Certified/Organic

These growers state that they follow organic practices. Under the National Organic Program (NOP), growers are exempt from certification if they have less than \$5,000 in annual sales of organic food products.

◆ Transitional

These growers are participating in the WSDA Organic Food Certification Program and are in the process of adopting organic practices, but have not completed the qualification process. They are certified by WSDA as Transitional.

☼ Sustainable

These growers try to use the pest disease and weed control methods that have minimal negative impact on the environment. They also strive for humane working conditions.

Washington State Department of Agriculture Organic Food Certification

The growth in organic and sustainable agriculture in Washington has been phenomenal. The state's organic food industry has grown a hundredfold since 1988. Farmers markets are thriving, providing gathering places that improve the quality of community life as well as the economic health of many small farms. Community-supported agriculture (box schemes) supports dozens of farms throughout the state. Domestic and export markets have expanded and provide markets for hundreds of organic farms. The Washington State Department of Agriculture's Organic Food Certification Program started 20 years ago and has been an integral component in the development of organic agriculture in Washington.

In 1987 the Washington State legislature authorized the establishment of the first state government Organic Certification Program in the United States. The Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) Organic Food Program certified 63 organic farms during the first year. These farms were relatively small with organic sales in 1988 totaling \$2.5 million.

The WSDA Organic Certification Program evolved out of the Tilth Producers certification program, which operated from 1977-1987. For a variety of reasons, Tilth Producers transferred certification authority to the state in 1987. WSDA worked with

Tilth and the organic community in a spirit of open communication to direct the development of the WSDA Organic Food Program. WSDA established an Organic Advisory Board that continues to guide the program.

The WSDA Organic Food Program now includes nearly 1,000 certified organic operations. WSDA has a material registration program to evaluate and approve products for organic agriculture, with more than 500 products currently registered.

The WSDA Organic Food Program certifies to the U.S. National Organic Standards and the European organic standards. The program is ISO Guide 65 accredited (1999), IFOAM accredited (2004) and has a product acceptance agreement with the British Soil Association. The program is recognized in Quebec, Canada, and has cooperative agreements with two Japanese certifiers to provide JAS (Japan Agricultural Standard) inspections for Washington organic operations.

The WSDA Organic Food Program ensures the integrity of organic food products. The program certifies organic producers and handlers to U.S. National Organic Standards and other countries' organic standards. The National Organic Standards Board defines organic agriculture as an ecological production management system that promotes and enhances biodiversity, biological cycles and soil biological activity. It is based on minimal use of off-farm inputs and management practices that restore, maintain and enhance ecological harmony.

Except for organic producers that sell less than \$5,000 worth of organic products, all organic producers must be certified by the WSDA and pay annual fees for certification based on annual gross sales of their products. The WSDA Organic Food Program is self-supporting from these fees.
