Funding

- Budget of roughly \$7 million
- Allocated \$5.2 million in grants to counties



Surveillance

 Gravid traps, CO₂-baited light traps, and larval dipping, plus a variety of other surveillance tools were primarily used

Surveillance and Identification

- 30,000 successful mosquito collections
- Collected 777,817 specimens
- 44 species
- Top 15 species represented 98.6% of total specimens collected

Avian Surveillance

- Dead bird surveillance and testing was limited to Corvids and Raptors
- Database for recording other species of dead birds
- 859 birds were sighted
- 122 were collected


Emphasis is on larval control

- Treated at least 129,193 catch basins
- Made 6,200 other larval applications
- Made 501 adult applications (ULV and Barrier)
- Made 4 aerial larviciding applications

WNV Testing (Mosquitoes)

Tested 457,453 specimens (84% Culex)

244 positive pools

Cx. pipiens	145
Cx. restuans	57
Cx. spp.	39
Cx. salinarius	2
Ae. vexans	1

Additional Virus Testing Results

- 92 dead birds tested for WNV– 10 positive corvids
- 4 WNV sentinel chicken flocks no positives
- Limited testing of LAC and EEE did not yield any positive results

Human Testing

- 9 human WNV cases plus 2 positive blood donors
- 1 human Chikungunya case
- 12 human Dengue cases

 Lyme disease – results not tabulated yet for 2007. PA usually in top 3 for human cases.

2008

- Dept. of Environmental Protection mosquito lab will supplement Dept. of Health lab with additional PCR testing of mosquito samples
- Will discontinue use of sentinel chickens
- Will continue testing Corvids and Raptors
