## Weeds are likely to invade burned areas. Watch for these and other invaders:



SPOTTED KNAPWEED Centaurea maculosa

Increases soil erosion and produces up to 1,000 seeds per plant.

DALMATIAN TOADFLAX *Linaria dalmatica* 

Looks like snapdragons and grows easily in almost any ecosystem.





DOWNY BROME, or CHEATGRASS Bromus tectorum

Produces fine-textured plant fuel that promotes more frequent and larger wildfires.

YELLOW STARTHISTLE Centaurea solstitialis

Germinates rapidly and drastically reduces forage for livestock and wildlife.



## NOW is the time to:

- · Survey burned areas for weeds
- Report weed infestations
- · Promptly treat weed infestations
- Restore groundcover in burned areas to prevent weed invasion
